UIC School of Public Health Estelle Goldstein Memorial Scholarship Fall 2016

<u>Description of Award</u>: The Estelle Goldstein Memorial Scholarship Fund honors the memory of Estelle Lorraine Goldstein, mother of Paul J. Goldstein, PhD, UIC SPH faculty member in epidemiology. The fund supports students who are enrolled in the School and can demonstrate financial need, with preference to be given to a student returning after the age of forty, and/or with interest in issues of aging and/or gerontology.

Award Amount: \$1,000. This is a tuition based scholarship that will be applied to any outstanding balance in your school account. Any award is reported to the department of financial aid and may result in an adjustment of need based aid.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Applicants must be students enrolled in the School of Public Health.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Recipients must have demonstrated financial need.
- Preference given to a student returning to school after the age of 40.
- Preference given to students whose research and education interests in the content areas of aging and/or gerontology.

Application Requirements: Your application must include the following components to be complete:

- Estelle Goldstein Memorial Scholarship Application, which includes:
 - Copy of student transcripts
 - Personal Statement (not to exceed three pages) Must provide descriptions of your research interests, and please include specifics if they currently address aging and/or gerontology. Include a discussion of your academic achievements.
 - One letter of support from a SPH faculty member The SNAP system allows you to enter the name and email address of the faculty member providing your letter. Please be sure to reach out to the faculty member before you enter their name in the system. Please be careful to correctly enter the faculty member's email address.
 - Current CV/Resume
 - Proof of financial need FAFSA report if available, or personal statement of financial need (not to exceed one page)

Application Deadline: Friday, November 25, 2016; late submissions will not be accepted.
