Bonnie C. Minsky Award
Fall 2016

Description of Award: The Bonnie C. Minsky Award was established to aid students in advancing research and public health knowledge in nutrition as it relates to the areas of maternal and child health, women's health, and/or healthy aging.

Award Amount: \$800. This is a tuition based scholarship that will be applied to any outstanding balance in your school account. Any award is reported to the department of financial aid and may result in an adjustment of need based aid.

Eligibility: Applicants must be students enrolled in the UIC School of Public Health.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Recipients selected based on academic merit, financial need, and interest in nutrition.
- Preference given to students whose research and education interests relate to nutritional aspects of maternal and child health, women's health, and/or healthy aging.

Application Requirements:

Your application must include the following components to be complete:

- Bonnie C. Minsky Award Application, which includes:
 - Copy of student transcripts
 - Personal Statement (not to exceed three pages) – Must describe your research and education interests in nutrition as it relates to maternal and child health, women's health, and/or healthy aging. Include a discussion of your academic achievements.
 - One letter of support from a SPH faculty member - The SNAP system allows you to enter the name and email address of the faculty member providing your letter. Please be sure to reach out to the faculty member before you enter their name in the system. Please be careful to correctly enter the faculty member's email address.
 - Current CV/Resume
 - Proof of financial need – FAFSA report if available, or personal statement of financial need (not to exceed one page)

Application Deadline: Friday, November 25, 2016; late submissions will not be accepted.
